30 September 2023

#### **Guidelines for authors**

Articles must be original and not previously published

Use a clear, informal writing style

#### Recommended word count

Sector overview article: 1,500 words, including references

Single topic article: 1,000 words, including references

### What is Ireland's Education Yearbook?

- **(1)** A record: An accessible and comprehensive data and news resource, accurately and fully covering the story of education in Ireland in a particular year
- (2) A think tank: A source of insightful commentary and blue-sky thinking on the big issues of the year in education
- (3) A catalyst for constructive action

We urge authors to reflect on these aims and to develop your articles in accordance with them. In addition to outlining the facts, we encourage you to ask leading questions which may inspire blue-sky thinking and open pathways to further discussion.

#### Launch

The launch of *Ireland's Education Yearbook* is organised annually by yearbook editor Dr Brian Mooney. *Ireland's Education Yearbook 2023* will be launched in January 2024.

#### **Ireland's Education Summit**

Authors in *Ireland's Education Yearbook 2023* may opt in as a speaker at Ireland's Education Summit 2024 by ticking the appropriate box on the Article Transmission Form.

Ireland's Education Summit provides a further opportunity for Yearbook authors to discuss and expand on their topics.
